Embracing the Future – A Catholic Education Perspective

Dr Lee-Anne Perry has been the Executive Director of the Queensland Catholic Education Commission since 27 July 2015. Prior to taking up that appointment, Dr Perry served as Principal of Mt Alvernia College, Kedron (1993-1998) and of Mt Carmel College, Wynnum (1990-1992). Dr Perry holds a Doctor of Education from the Queensland University of Technology, a Master of Education, Bachelor of Education (First Class Honours) and Diploma of Christian Leadership. Dr Perry is the Deputy Chair of the National Catholic Education Commission.

Nurturing New Horizons – A University Perspective

Professor Helen Bartlett commenced as the third Vice-Chancellor and President of the University of the Sunshine Coast (USC) in August 2020. Prior to joining USC, Professor Bartlett was Vice-Chancellor and President of Federation University Australia from 2017 to 2020, Pro Vice-Chancellor and Chief Executive of Monash University Malaysia from 2013 to 2017, and Pro Vice-Chancellor and President of Monash University's Gippsland Campus from 2008 to 2012. Professor Bartlett attained a Bachelor of Arts at Northumbria University, a Master of Science (Public Policy) and a PhD from the University of Bath, and is a research specialist in health and aged care.

Co-Creating Educational Futures: Contradictions Between Emerging Future and the Walled Past – Where Are We Heading?

Professor Sohail Inayatullah is the inaugural UNESCO Chair in Futures Studies. He is now Chair in waiting at the Sejahtera Center for Sustainability and Humanity, IIUM. He is a political scientist/futurist at Tamkang University, Taipei, an Associate at Melbourne Business School; the University of Melbourne; and a researcher at Metafuture.org, a global think-tank. From 2001-2020, he was Adjunct Professor from the University of the Sunshine Coast, Australia. From 2011-2014, he was Adjunct Professor at the Centre for policing, counter-terrorism and intelligence, Macquarie University, Sydney. In 1999, he was the UNESCO Chair in European Studies at the University of Trier, Germany.
